Project Management Professional (PMP)[®] is one of the most widelyrespected credentials in the global project management community.

PMP® Exam 2021: What You Need to Know

A new PMP[®] exam has been in effect since January 2nd 2021.

Our PMP[®] exam preparation course is fully aligned with the PMI[®] Examinations Content Outline ECO May 2021.

The course is aligned with *A Guide to the Project Management Body of Knowledge (PMBOK® Guide)* - Sixth Edition and the *Agile Practice Guide 2017*. While the *PMBOK® Guide* has not been changed, the PMI® has introduced a higher content of agile and hybrid questions on the exam.



The new exam is structured along three domains with the proportion of questions as follows:

✓ People 42%
✓ Process 50%
✓ Business Environment 8%

PMP[®] Exam 2021: What You Need to Know

The sixth edition of the *PMBOK*[®] *Guide* introduced a higher level of consideration for agile practices, and this is continued in the new exam format.

Rather than concentrating on a predictive (often called "traditional" or "conventional") approach to project management, throughout all 3 domains, attention and value will be given to predictive and agile approaches, and to a hybrid of both.



- The programme includes predictive, agile and hybrid project management approaches found across the three domains.
- 50% of the exam is expected to be based on agile and hybrid approaches and 50% based on predictive or plan based approaches.

How can you get PMP[®] contact hours?

One of the PMP[®] exam eligibility requirements is that you must have at least 35 contact hours of formal project management education unless you are an active CAPM[®] certification holder.

You can acquire contact hours through completion of training courses or programmes with established education providers.

Application Process & Exam Fees



What is the PMP[®] application process?

In order to be eligible to sit the PMP[®] exam, you will need to complete the PMI's application process.

The application confirms your eligibility and documents your project management experience.

Don't Worry:

During our PMP[®] Exam Preparation Course, we will give you tips and guidance on completing your PMP[®] application successfully.

Once you have completed and submitted your application, it will be reviewed by the PMI[®]. This can take up to 5 days.



What are the PMP[®] exam fees?

Your exam fees will be payable directly to the PMI[®] once they indicate you have qualified to move forward.

Examination fees are \$405 (USD) for PMI[®] members and \$555 (USD) for non-members. This is an indicative cost, correct as of September 2021. Please check <u>www.pmi.org</u> for current details.

Breaking down the PMP[®] exam

QUESTIONS

How many questions are on the new PMP[®] exam?

There are 180 questions in total. Of those questions, 175 are scored (5 are pilot or "pre-test" questions that do not affect your score).

What kinds of questions are on the new PMP[®] exam?

Questions will be a combination of the following styles: multiple-choice, multiple responses, matching, limited fill-in-the-gap.

WEIGHTING

The new PMP[®] exam is divided between the three domains: people, processes, and business environment.

The weighting of questions is divided as: People – 42%, Processes – 50%, Business Environment – 8%

Approximately half of the exam will represent predictive project management approaches and the other half will represent agile or hybrid approaches.

These approaches are represented across the three domains and not isolated to a particular area or task.

DURATION

The exam is 230 minutes in total. During this time, you will have two 10-minute breaks. The exam is divided into 3 sections:

Section 1: Questions 1 - 60 Break one occurs after you complete question 60 and review your answers.

Section 2: Questions 61 – 120 Break two occurs after you complete question 120 and review your answers.

Section 3: Questions 121 – 180 Once you review your responses and start each break you will not be able to return to the questions from the previous section.

Passing the PMP[®] Exam

What score do you need to pass the PMP[®] Exam?

This is one of the most frequently asked PMP[®] questions online and it is one of the most difficult-to-define answers.

The traditional answer was always "61%". As the PMI[®] no longer disclose the marks needed to pass the PMP[®] exam, we cannot now take this as being accurate.

The PMI[®] now follow a grading system that uses "sound psychometric analysis" to determine the passing score. (source: The PMP[®] Handbook)

Exam Re-Takes

If you do not pass your PMP[®] exam on the first try, you can re-sit it up to two more times within your 1-year eligibility period.

Given the work you have done to get to the PMP[®] Exam stage, re-sitting the exam in this situation is a wise move. It is likely you will simply need more preparation time before your second attempt.
